Can Mouse Motion Reveal Your Mood? Modelling Player Emotions During First-Person Shooters

Why have I been chosen?

I am inviting anyone who is computer literate with an interest in video games and between the ages of 18 and 35 to attend the study if they want to.

What would I be asked to do if I take part?

Play video games in three-minute sessions, reporting your experiences during the play by

answering a series of short questions.

What happens to the data collected?

Electronic data will be stored securely on a computer. Written information will be stored in a locked drawer. The information will be used in preparation of my dissertation and towards a publication in the scientific literature.

How is confidentiality maintained?

Outside the study, where some data is used to identify players between sessions, data will be made anonymous (names and any other information that may identify an individual will not be stored with the data), so no one will be able to recognize who the data belongs to.

Will I be paid for participating in the research?

You will not be paid for participating in this research.

What is the duration of the research?

Each game will last three minutes and each questionnaire will take less than three minutes to complete. Each set of games should take about ten minutes to complete. Participants may play as many or as few games as they wish up to a maximum of two hours.
